

Pursuant to Tenn. R. Civ. P. 65.03(5), the Temporary Restraining Order is extended until the parties agree on the terms of a Temporary Injunction and it is entered by the Court or until the Court holds a hearing and enters an Order granting or denying the requested injunctive relief.

If the parties cannot come to an agreement as to a Temporary Injunction by **Friday, July 17, 2026**, the parties shall notify the Court and shall propose dates for the resetting of the Temporary Injunction Hearing in this matter and a briefing schedule.

It is so **ORDERED**.
