Uninsured Adults	the percentage of adults under age 65 without health insurance	
Uninsured Children	the percentage of children under age 19 without health insurance	
High School Completion	the percentage of adults ages 25 and over with a high school diploma or equivalent	
Some College	the percentage of adults ages 25-44 with some post-secondary education	
Children in Poverty	the percentage of people under age 18 in poverty	
Median Household Income	the income where half of households in a county earn more and half of households earn less	
Severe Housing Problems	the percentage of households with at least 1 of 4 housing problems: overcrowding, high housing costs, lack of kitchen facilities, or lack of plumbing facilities	
Medical Debt*	the percentage of the population with medical debt in collections	
Patients to Primary Care Physicians Ratio	the number of people served by one primary care physician
